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Letter from the Presidents

Dear Supporters and Friends of the ATJ Campaign,

Since the Access to Justice Campaign was centralized in 2018, the Michigan legal community has demonstrated a sustained commitment to advancing access to justice for individuals and families across our state by its support of the Campaign. We are pleased to share the **2025 ATJ Campaign Annual Report**, highlighting the impact of this collective investment and the work of the ATJ Campaign's 14 participating legal aid programs.

In 2025, members of the legal community contributed \$1.2 million to support civil legal aid. 47 law firms with two or more attorneys were recognized as Leadership Firms because they gave \$300 per lawyer or more to the Campaign. The Campaign launched a new giving initiative, Champions of Impact, recognizing supporters who contribute \$10,000 or more. In 2025, we were proud to celebrate 41 Champions of Impact.

The ATJ Campaign continues to gain momentum each year. To increase support, the Foundation has added an impact gifts manager, an engagement manager, and a chief development officer. This expanded team will focus on retaining annual supporters, developing new supporters and expanding major gift relationships including planned giving. The goal remains to increase the financial support for civil legal aid to help our most vulnerable Michigan neighbors.

As members of the legal profession, we are uniquely positioned to strengthen access to justice. Civil legal challenges often carry lasting consequences, and timely legal representation can be critical to stability and opportunity. Investing in the ATJ Campaign reflects a shared commitment to expand access to legal representation and improve outcomes for low-income Michiganders.

We thank you for your continued support as we work collectively to increase the positive impact that the legal community has on providing legal aid in Michigan.

In 2023 and 2024, for every **\$1 invested** in Michigan legal aid, the people of Michigan **received \$5.49** in immediate and long-term consequential financial benefits, a **549% return on investment**.

Serving Michigan Communities through Legal Aid

Your contributions to the Access to Justice Campaign helped to expand the resources available for the 14 participating programs. 100% of contributions are distributed to these programs.

Approximately **1.7 Million** low-income Michiganders qualify for civil legal aid. In **2025**, the participating programs delivered a range of legal services to **103,784 people** in households including **44,894 children**.

Client Impact Stories

Restoring Dignity and Autonomy

After a stroke, Ben became the subject of a guardianship petition filed by a hospital system. At a hearing where he was not given the opportunity to speak, the court appointed a temporary guardian. In the weeks that followed, the guardian failed to meet even basic responsibilities. Ben was evicted from his apartment and went without necessary care and medication.

Legal Aid intervened at the next hearing. With representation, the situation was reexamined, and the hospital withdrew its guardianship petition.

Ben has since established trusted decision-making arrangements, restoring his autonomy and ensuring his needs are properly managed.

Securing Homeownership and Ensuring Stability

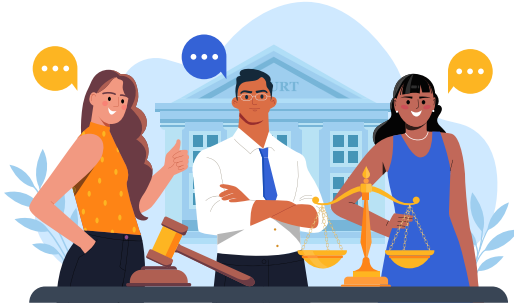
After working diligently to pay off her mobile home, Bonnie repeatedly requested that the mobile home park transfer the title to her, but they failed to do so.

When the park moved to evict her for nonpayment five years later, Bonnie faced the loss of her home. In court, her legal aid attorney raised the unresolved issue that despite having paid for the home in full, the park had never transferred the title.

The park ultimately transferred the title to Bonnie and agreed to reduce the amount of rent owed in recognition of their failure to act. A structured payment plan brought the account current and allowed Bonnie to remain in her home with her ownership formally acknowledged.

With legal support, Bonnie was able to assert her rights, secure her housing, and move forward with greater stability.

Expanding the Impact of Civil Legal Aid through Volunteer Attorney Partnerships



Partnerships between legal aid programs and volunteer attorneys remain essential to expanding access to civil legal aid.

In addition to direct representation, many volunteer attorneys can support this work through financial contributions—ensuring that participating programs have the resources needed to deliver services effectively.

Restoring Stability and Ensuring Safety

Alice, a domestic violence survivor, reached out to Legal Aid after her husband filed for divorce, moved out, withdrew equity from their home, and took out a reverse mortgage on the house, while continuing to threaten and pressure her to leave the home. Legal Aid connected Alice with a pro bono attorney.

Alice ultimately secured her share of the proceeds from the sale of the home, allowing her to move forward and establish a new living situation.

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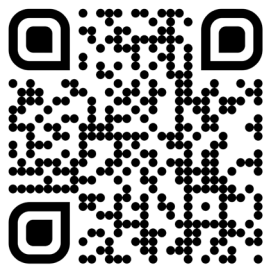
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
